Refreshment **Vehicle Class C Compliance Checklist**

City of Brampton Mobile Licensing By-law Update (2025)



All Class C refreshment vehicles (food trucks) **must meet** updated zoning, licensing and operational requirements. Use this checklist to ensure your operation is compliant.

Location Requirements

At least 50 metres away from:

Brick-and-mortar restaurants / fixed

- Operating in a Commercial or Industrial Zone
- Not obstructing:
 - Landscaping areas
 - Required parking spaces, loading bays or drive aisles
 - Traffic sightlines (visibility triangles)

Health & Safety Requirements

- Garbage bin provided on-site and emptied daily
- Washroom facilities available and accessible on-site to staff and patrons
- Site is kept clean and free of litter, waste

food premise

Property Permission

- Written permission from the property owner, confirming:
 - Zoning compliance and access to washroom facilities for staff and patrons
 - Site map of refreshment vehicle

Permission letter includes:

- Address of the operating site
- Names and contact information of property owner and operator

Licensing & Compliance

and debris

Distance Requirements

- For one to three refreshment vehicles on a property: each must be at least 5 metres apart
- For more than three refreshment vehicles on a property: each additional vehicle must be at least 10 metres apart

- Valid Class C Refreshment Vehicle licence
- Permission letter includes:
 - Business Licensing By-Law
 - Zoning By-Law
 - Updating Mobile Licensing By-Law (2025)
