Number 5-79

To amend By-law 86-77 being a By-law to establish a Board of Management for The Four Corners Improvement Area.

WHEREAS the Board of Management for The Four Corners Improvement Area have requested City Council to increase the Board from seven members to nine members;


AND WHEREAS City Council at its meeting held on December 18th, 1978 approved the said request;


THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- (1) Clause 3 of By-law 86-77 be deleted and the following substituted therefore:

The Board shall consist of nine members, appointed by Council, two of whom shall be members of Council and the remaining members shall be persons qualified to be elected members of Council assessed for business assessment in respect of land in the area or nominees of corporations so assessed, provided that such nominees are persons qualified to be elected as members of the Council.
