Number 12-2006

A By-law to Amend Traffic By-law 93-93
to prohibit the parking of vehicles
which project over the curb

Whereas Section 11(1) 1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* permits a local municipality to pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 42 of Traffic By-law 93-93 is amended by adding the following section:

42(7A) in such a manner that the vehicle is partly on a boulevard, or on public or private property,

and projects over a curb into the traveled portion of the highway;

2. The following is added to Traffic By-law 93-93, after Section 55:


UNLICENSED VEHICLES

55.1 No person shall park an unlicensed or immobile vehicle on a highway or on municipal property.
