# BY-LAW

Number 18-2006

A Parking Exemption By-law Applicable to  
Part of the Area Subject to Zoning By-Law 270-2004

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


1. Zoning By-Law 270-2004 is hereby further amended as follows:

(1). Section 20.3.3 is deleted and replaced with the following:

"20.3.3 The lands shown outlined and identified as "Parking Exemption Area" on Schedule B to this by-law shall be exempt from the parking requirements set out in Section 20.3.2 for a commercial use only, and for a temporary period expiring on December 31, 2006."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL, this 30<sup>th</sup> day of JANUARY, 2006.



DECLARATION
