# BY-LAW

Number 23-80

To designate the City of Brampton Library and Art Gallery as a place appointed for the purpose of keeping certain documents.

WHEREAS Section 215(e) of The Municipal Act (R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284, as amended) provides that the Council of a municipality may appoint a place, other than the office of the Clerk, for the keeping of the originals of by-laws and of minutes of the proceedings of Council;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. The City of Brampton Library and Art Gallery is hereby appointed as a place to keep the originals of all by-laws and of all minutes of the proceedings of
  - (a) the Council of the former Corporation of the Township of Chinguacousy for the years from incorporation up to and including 1973.
