A Parking Exemption By-law Applicable to Part of the Area Subject to Zoning
By-law 270-2004


The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 270-2004, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) Section 20.3.3 is deleted and replaced with the following:

"20.3.3 The lands shown outlined and identified as "Parking Exemption Area" on Schedule B-5 to this by-law shall be exempt from the parking requirements set out in Section 20.3.2 for a commercial use only, and for a temporary period expiring on December 31, 2007."

DECLARATION


I, Joan LeFeuvre, of the Town of Halton Hills, in the Region of Halton, hereby make oath and say as follows:
