A by-law to amend Woodlot Conservation By-law
402-2005


WHEREAS By-law 402-2005 was passed pursuant to the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, s. 391(1) to prohibit or regulate the destruction or injuring of trees in woodlots designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Committee of Council Recommendation CW048-2006 approved by City Council on February 13, 2006, fees related to permits under the Woodlot Conservation By-law are to be a part of the User Fee By-law, rather than incorporated within the Woodlot Conservation By-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That By-law 402-2005 is hereby amended by deleting in subsection 6.2 (a) and substituting therefor the following:
 - “(a) be accompanied by the applicable fee as prescribed in User Fee Bylaw 380-2003, as amended”;
2. That By-law 402-2005 is hereby further amended to delete Schedule “A”.


