Number 37 - 2026

To establish certain lands as part of the public highway system (Boundary Creek Path and Brasstown Valley Trail)

Whereas it is deemed expedient to establish certain lands as part of the public highway system.

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows:

1. The lands acquired by The Corporation of the City of Brampton and described as Reserve Block 36 on Plan 43M-2182 is hereby established as part of the public highway system to be part of Boundary Creek Path.
2. The lands acquired by The Corporation of the City of Brampton and described as Reserve Block 37 on Plan 43M-2182 is hereby established as part of the public highway system to be part of Brasstown Valley Trail.
3. The lands acquired by The Corporation of the City of Brampton and described as Reserve Block 92 on Plan 43M-2002 is hereby established as part of the public highway system to be part of Boundary Creek Path.
4. The lands acquired by The Corporation of the City of Brampton and described as Reserve Block 93 on Plan 43M-2002 is hereby established as part of the public highway system to be part of Brasstown Valley Trail.
