Number 43-93

To amend By-law 281-85 being
a by-law to establish a
local advisory committee under
the Ontario Heritage Act
(Brampton Heritage Board)

WHEREAS By-law 281-85 was passed on the 16th day of October, 1985, to establish a local advisory committee under the Ontario Heritage Act, to be known as the Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee (LACAC), and also known as the Brampton Heritage Board, to be composed of not fewer than 5, and not more than 9, members, to be appointed by a resolution of the Council;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient to increase the maximum number of members from 9 to 11;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. That By-law 281-85 is hereby amended to delete paragraph 2 and substitute therefor the following:

"The Brampton Heritage Board shall be composed of not fewer than 5, and not more than 11, members, to be appointed by a resolution of the Council."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 8th day of March, 1993.
