Number 52-87

To amend By-law 56-83 (part of Lot 4, Concession 9, Northern Division, in the geographic Township of Toronto Gore)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 56-83, as amended, and as specifically amended by By-law 330-85, is hereby further amended:

(1) by deleting clause (1) of By-law 330-85 and substituting therefor the following:


"(1) by changing the zoning classification of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from AGRICULTURAL (A) to INDUSTRIAL ONE-SECTION 536 (M1-SECTION 536), such lands being part of Lot 4, Concession 9, Northern Division, in the geographic Township of Toronto Gore."
