A By-law to make it lawful for  
any person to engage in or be  
present at certain activities on  
The Lord's Day


WHEREAS The Brampton Flower Festival Association represents  
that it is a corporation incorporated without share capital.


AND WHEREAS the said Association proposes to hold part of its  
annual exhibition and show on Sunday the 23rd day of June,  
1974.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of  
Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 6 of The Lord's Day (Ontario) Act, 1970, Chapter  
259 is hereby declared to apply in the Corporation of the  
City of Brampton in respect of the activities hereinafter  
specified, namely, the operation of a "midway" including  
shows, riding devices and concessions not otherwise  
prohibited by law at the Fairgrounds, Elliott Street,  
Brampton, by the Brampton Flower Festival Association as  
part of and in conjunction with its annual exhibition and  
show.
2. The said activities specified in Clause 1 shall be limited  
to the period between the hours of 2:00 and 6:00 o'clock  
in the afternoon of Sunday, the 23rd day of June, 1974  
but nothing in this Clause 2 shall in anyway limit the  
time during which the said Association may conduct any  
aspect of its exhibition and show which is not unlawful  
under The Lord's Day Act (Canada).
3. The Brampton Flower Festival Association shall conduct  
the activities hereby permitted in an orderly manner.

READ A FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME PASSED in open Council
