BY-LAW

Number 60-80

To authorize a capital expenditure
in the amount of \$33,750.00 for the
construction of certain sidewalks

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton desires to undertake the construction of certain sidewalks as set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton shall undertake the construction of those sidewalks as set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law at a total estimated cost of \$33,750.00.
2. That the Mayor and the Treasurer are hereby authorized in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from the Royal Bank of Canada, 1 Main Street North, Brampton, a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$33,750.00 for the aforementioned purpose and to give on behalf of the Corporation to the Royal Bank of Canada a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Mayor and the Treasurer for the money so borrowed with interest which may be paid in advance or otherwise.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 10th day of March, 1980.

SCHEDULE "A" TO BY-LAW 60-80

1. STEELES AVENUE (north side) from McLaughlin Road to Fletcher's Creek, a distance of approximately 335 metres.
2. McLAUGHLIN ROAD (west side) from Steeles Avenue to approximately 150 metres South
3. KENNEDY ROAD (east side) from Linkdale Road to approximately 275 metres North
4. HIGHWAY NUMBER 7 (north side) from Torbram Road to approximately 140 metres West
5. TORBRAM ROAD (west side) from Balmoral Drive to East Drive, a distance of approximately 420 metres
