BY-LAW

Number 65-87

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plans M-702, M-715, M-716 and M-727 (Bramalea Limited)


WHEREAS subsection 49(5) of the Planning Act, 1983 has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 49(7) of the Planning Act, 1983, the council of a municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans or parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 5 of section 49 of the Planning Act, 1983 (S.O. 1983, c.1, as amended) does not apply to the land that is described in Schedule A to this by-law.
2. This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by the Regional Municipality of Peel.
