A By-law to Amend By-law Number 33-79 being a by-law for the Regulation of Traffic

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient and advisable to amend By-law Number 33-79, being a by-law for the regulation of traffic;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. By-law Number 33-79 is hereby further amended by the deletion from Schedule VIII of the following items under the appropriate columns thereof

THROUGH HIGHWAYS

COLUMN 1 Highway

COLUMN 2 Between

Beech Street

The South limit of Salisbury Circle and the East limit of Centre Street.

- 2. By-law Number 33-79 is hereby further amended by the addition to Schedule IX of the following items under the appropriate columns thereof

STOP SIGNS

COLUMN 1 Intersection

COLUMN 2 Facing Traffic

Beech Street & Salisbury Circle
Beech Street & Salisbury Circle
Beech Street & Salisbury Circle

Northbound on Beech St.
Southbound on Beech St.
Eastbound on Salisbury Circle.

- 3. The provisions of this by-law shall not become effective until approved by the Council of the Regional Municipality of Peel.
