# BY-LAW

To amend By-law 193-83, as amended,  
in respect of parking fines

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton  
ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 193-83, as amended, being a by-law for the regulation of traffic on City of Brampton Highways, is hereby further amended;
  - (1) by deleting from section (1) subsection (i) of Part 6 the words "Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00)" and substituting therefor the words "Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)", and by deleting the words "Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)" and substituting therefor the words "Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)".
  - (2) by deleting from section 3 subsection (i) of Part 4 of the words "Where signs to that effect are displayed, no person shall park any vehicle on any highway:" and substituting therefor the words "The Commissioner of Public Works may cause signs to be posted prohibiting parking:"

(3) by adding to section 3 subsection (i) of Part 4 the following as paragraph k):

"k) on any highway at the side and between the limits set out respectively in Columns 1, 2, and 3 on Schedule I to this by-law during the prohibited times or days set out in column 4 of the said Schedule."

(4) by adding to section 3 subsection (i) of Part 4 the following as paragraph l):

"l) on any highway at the side and between the limits set out respectively in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule III to this by-law during the times or days set out in Column 4 of the said Schedule for a longer period than that set out in Column 5 of the said Schedule."

(5) by adding to section 3 of Part 4 the following as subsection ii):

"ii) No person shall park any vehicle on any highway or portion thereof where a sign has been posted by the Commissioner of Public Works pursuant to subsection (i) of this section, or section 2 subsection 3 of Part 2 of this by-law."

(6) by deleting from section 4 subsection (i) of Part 4 the words "Where signs to that effect are displayed, no person shall stop any vehicle on any highway:" and substituting therefor the words "The Commissioner of Public Works may cause signs to be posted prohibiting stopping:"

(7) by adding to section 4 subsection (i) the following as paragraph k):

"k) on any highway at the side and between the limits set out respectively in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule II to this by-law during the prohibited times or days set out in Column 4 of the said Schedule."

(8) by adding to section 4 of Part 4 the following as subsection ii):

"ii) No person shall stop any vehicles on any highway or portion thereof where a sign has been posted by the Commissioner of Public Works pursuant to subsection (i) of this section".

2. Sections 1, 2 and 3 of Part 5 of By-law 193-83, as amended, are hereby repealed.
