The council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 193-83, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

(1) by deleting from the specified columns of Schedule VIII thereto the following item:

THROUGH HIGHWAYS

COLUMN 1 HIGHWAY	COLUMN 2 BETWEEN
John Street	The east limit of Centre Street and the west limit of Trueman Street

(2) by adding to the specified columns of Schedule IX thereto the following items:

STOP SIGNS

COLUMN 1 INTERSECTION	COLUMN 2 FACING TRAFFIC
John Street and Lynch Street	Southbound on Lynch Street
John Street and Lynch Street	Westbound on John Street
John Street and Lynch Street	Northbound on Lynch Street
John Street and Lynch Street	Eastbound on John Street

This by-law shall not come into force until approved by the council of The Regional Municipality of Peel.
