To amend Schedule "A" of the Administrative Penalties (Non-Parking) By-law
218-2019

WHEREAS By-law 218-2019 "Administrative Penalties (Non-Parking) By-law" was enacted to provide for a system of administrative penalties for designated by-laws

AND WHEREAS the Council for The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it appropriate to provide for administrative penalties to enforce the provisions of the Business Licensing By-Law 184-2023

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows:

1. That Schedule "A" of Administrative Penalties (Non-Parking) By-law 218-2019, as amended, be further amended by removing the existing table in Section 3 of Schedule "A" and replacing it with the update table included in this By-law:

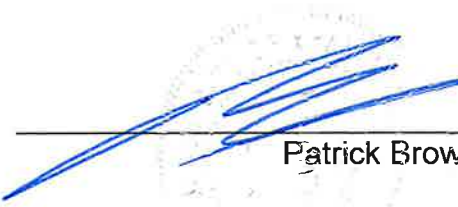
