# BY-LAW


To amend Interim Control By-law 306-2003, an Interim Control By-law applicable to Part of the Area Subject to By-law 270-2004, as amended, and known municipally as 9726 Heritage Road

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The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


1. By-law 306-2003 as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:
  - (1) Section 1 is amended by adding after the words "Except as provided for in Section 1.1, Section 1.2 and Section 1.3, Section 1.5, Section 1.6, section 1.7 and 1.8 and Section 1.9, Section 1.10, Section 1.11 Section 1.12, Section 1.4 and Section 1.14 the lands described as Part of Lots 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17 Concession 5, WHS and Lots 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and Parts of Lots 8, 9, and 10 Concession 6 WHS as outlined on Schedule A to this by-law shall not have any buildings or structures erected thereon, except for those existing on the date of enactment of this by-law," the following:  
"and Section 1.15".
  - (2) The following is added as Section 1.15:
    - 1.14 The lands described as 9726 Heritage Road, PART OF LOT 9, CONCESSION 6 W.H.S. and referenced as the "Lands subject to specific exemption from Interim Control By-law 306-2003", as amended by By-Law 106-2013 " as outlined on Schedule A to this by-law shall permit the development of an accessory structure for agricultural purposes, set back no greater than approximately 55 metres from Heritage Road.
  - (3) Schedule A is deleted and replaced with Schedule A attached to this by-law.

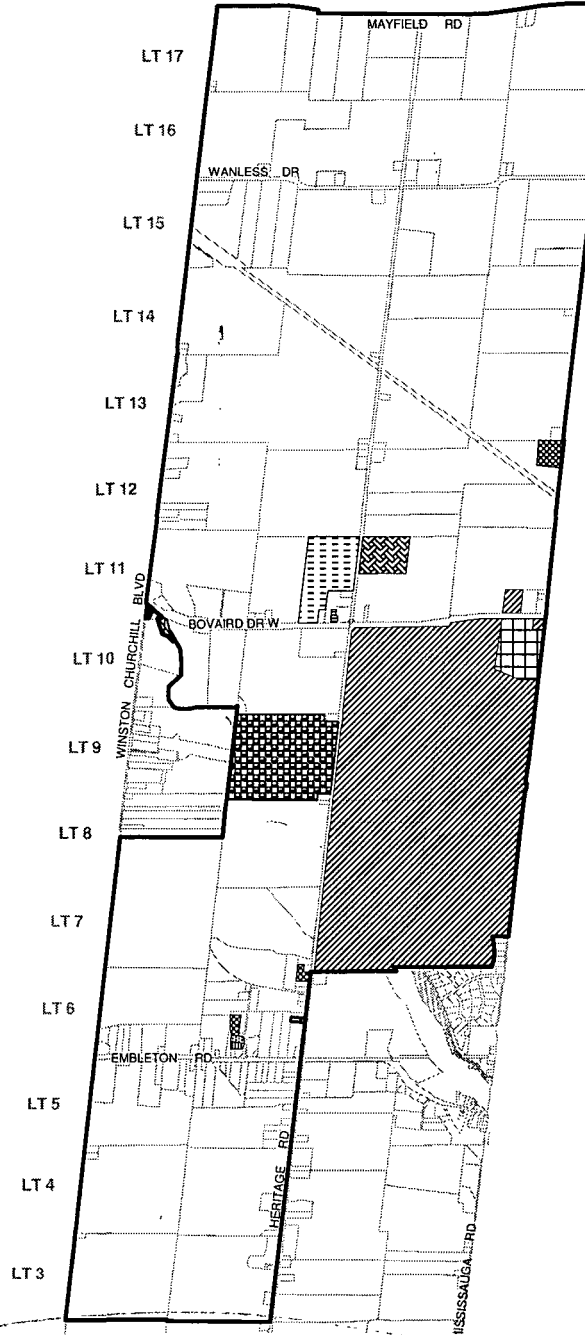
