To amend the Residential Rental Licensing By-Law 216-2023 Insurance Requirements

WHEREAS By-law 216-2023 the Residential Rental By-law was enacted to provide for a system of licensing Residential Rentals

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows:

1. That Part XI, section 50 of Residential Rental By-law be amended by removing the current section 50 of the By-law and replacing it with new section 50 as follows;

50. Every Person shall provide the Licence Issuer with at least fifteen (15) days' notice in writing, by regular mail, personal delivery, e-mail or fax delivery, of cancellation, expiration or variation in the amount or conditions of the policy required by Subsection 61(1).
