To Assume and Dedicate Land as
Road Allowance

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton
ENACTS as follows:

1. That the lands shown as Part 34 on a Plan of expropriation of the Township of Chinguacousy, now in the City of Brampton, registered on November 8th, 1968 and more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto attached, are hereby assumed and dedicated as a public highway and named First Line East (1st Line East) in the City of Brampton.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 12th day of June, 1978.
