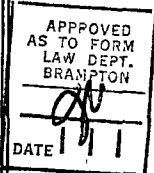
To amend By-law 56-83

1. By-law 56-83, as amended, is hereby further amended:

- (1) by deleting the words "a mixed serviced restaurant" in sections 23.1.1(a), 24.1.1(a)(5), and section 24.2.1(d), and substituting therefore the words "a fast food restaurant, a standard restaurant".
