1. By-law 200-82, as amended, and as specifically amended by By-law 62-93, is hereby further amended:

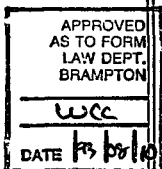
- (1) by adding to section 374.2 thereof the following:

"374.2 (7) minimum interior side yard width: 2.0 metres."

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
