# BY-LAW

Number 168-80

A By-law to regulate the use of locomotive whistles.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to prohibit the sounding of any engine whistle in accordance with the provisions of Section 248 (1) of the Railway Act at the intersection of the Canadian Pacific Railway, Orangeville Subdivision with Second Line West, McLaughlin Road, McMurphy Avenue, Jessie Street, Queen Street West, Nelson Street, Dennison Avenue, Railroad Street, Joseph Street, Rosedale Avenue, English Street and Spur Line off Highway 10 in the City of Brampton.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton, as follows:

1. That the sounding of any engine whistle in accordance with the provisions of Section 248 (1) of the Railway Act, in respect of the following highway crossings within the limits of the City of Brampton is hereby prohibited.
