
A By-law to authorize a capital expenditure in the amount of \$1,125,000.00 for the construction of certain works.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton desires to undertake the construction of certain works as set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton shall undertake the construction of those works as set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto at a total estimated cost of \$1,125,000.00.
2. That the Mayor and Treasurer are hereby authorized in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from the Royal Bank of Canada, 1 Main Street North, Brampton, a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$1,125,000.00 for the aforementioned purpose and to give on behalf of the Corporation to the Royal Bank of Canada a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Mayor and the Treasurer for the money so borrowed with interest which may be paid in advance or otherwise.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 9th day of July, 1979.

<u>Intersection Improvements at the Clark Boulevard - West Drive Intersection</u> Construction of intersection improvements at the Clark Boulevard - West Drive intersection on Clark Boulevard from West Drive to 150 metres westerly and on West Drive from 115 metres north of Clark Boulevard to 115 metres south of Clark Boulevard	\$125,000.00	\$ 65,000.00
<u>Watercourse Improvements on Mimico Creek from Eastbourne Drive to Torbram Road.</u> Reshaping the existing watercourse, constructing a concrete lined channel and weirs, landscaping and related works.	225,000.00	110,000.00
<u>Reconstruction of English Street to 460 feet West of Murray Street.</u> including storm sewers, excavation, granular base, concrete curb and gutter, asphalt paving, sidewalks and related work. (Approximately 1,050 feet.)	150,000.00	40,000.00
<u>Reconstruction of McVean Drive (8th Line East) from No.10 Sideroad to No.15 Sideroad.</u> including excavation, grading, granular base, ditching, asphalt paving and related work. (Approximately 3,075 metres.)	550,000.00	300,000.00
<u>Torbram Road - Highway No.7 Intersection Improvements.</u> Widening the Torbram Road section of the intersection north and south of Highway No.7 to allow for separate left turn lanes, including excavation, grading, granular base, curb and gutter, asphalt paving and related work. (approximately 290 metres.)	25,000.00	13,000.00
<u>Union Street - Queen Street Intersection Improvements</u> From Queen Street to 75 metres northerly on Union Street including excavation, retaining wall construction, granular base, curb and gutter, asphalt paving, sidewalk and related works.	50,000.00	25,000.00
