A By-law to amend By-law 333-2013, the “Administrative Penalties By-law”

WHEREAS By-law 93-93 (“Traffic By-law”) was enacted to regulate the use of highways and parking;

AND WHEREAS By-law 333-2013 “Administrative Penalties By-law” was enacted to provide for a system of administrative penalties for By-law 93-93;

AND WHEREAS Council for The Corporation of the City of Brampton passed CW105-2023 at Committee of Council meeting on March 8, 2023;

AND WHEREAS Council for The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it appropriate to increase the administrative penalties for interference with snow clearing operations under By-law 93-93 (“Traffic By-law”); and

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS** as follows:


1. That Schedule “A” of the Administrative Penalty By-Law 333-2013, as amended, be amended by deleting Item 21 (Section 44) in its entirety and replacing it with the following:
