To amend By-law 380-2003 (User Fees)
regarding Electric Vehicle Charging Stations

WHEREAS Section 391 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws imposing fees for services provided by the municipality,

AND WHEREAS Council enacted By-law 280-2003, as amended, to provide for fees for services;

AND WHEREAS Council passed resolution CW258-2023 to require user fees for the use of City electric vehicle charging stations;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule E to User Fee By-law 380-2003 is amended by updating the following fees:


