
To provide for the payment of

trust companies


WHEREAS subsection 527(8) of The Municipal Act (R.S.O. 1970, c.284, as amended) provides that the council of any municipality may by by-law direct that moneys payable to the municipality for taxes or rates shall be paid by the person charged with the payment thereof into such chartered bank of Canada or trust company, as the council shall by such by-law direct, to the credit of the treasurer of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Moneys payable to the municipality for taxes or rates may be paid by the person charged with the payment thereof into any chartered bank of Canada, or any trust company, having an office within the boundaries of the Regional Municipality of Peel.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 7th day of July, 1980.

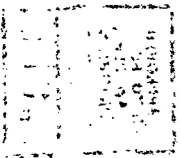
