BY-LAW

Number
A by-law to designate the whole of the City of Brampton as an area of Demolition Control
Whereas the provisions of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, Section 33 provides that when a by-law prescribing standards for the maintenance and occupancy of property is in force in a municipality, the municipality may by by-law designate any area within the municipality as an area of demolition control;
AND WHEREAS By-law No. 104-96 being the Property Standards By-law applies to the whole of the City of Brampton;
AND WHEREAS planning considerations make it desirable that the area of demolition control apply to the whole of the City of Brampton; and
Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts that the whole of the City of Brampton is hereby designated as an area of demolition control.
