A By-law to authorize a capital expenditure in the amount of \$425,000.00 for the construction of certain renovations to existing Recreation Centres.


WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton desires to undertake the construction of certain renovations to existing Recreation Centres;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton shall undertake the construction of certain renovations to existing Recreation Centres as set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto at a total estimated cost of \$425,000.00.
2. That the Mayor and the Treasurer are hereby authorized in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from the Royal Bank of Canada, 1 Main Street North, Brampton, a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$425,000.00 for the aforementioned purpose and to give on behalf of the Corporation to the Royal Bank of Canada a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Mayor and the Treasurer for the money so borrowed with interest which may be paid in advance or otherwise.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 10th day of September, 1979.

SCHEDULE "A"

Renovations to Existing Recreation Centres

1. Avondale Recreation Centre
Roof, windows, eaves, drainage, tiles, flooring.
2. Snelgrove Community Centre
Roof, eaves, drainage, tiles, drains.
3. Greenbriar Recreation Centre
Drainage, tiles, storms, header trench, walls, piping, rustproofing.
4. Rosalea Arena
Walls and venting, surface lighting, condenser.
5. Howden Recreation Centre
Filtration system, chlorinator.
6. Earnscliffe Recreation Centre
Chlorinator, filtration and heating systems, ceiling and wall repairs.
7. Curling Club
Header trench and perimeter drainage, downspouts to storms.
8. Century Gardens
Condenser.
9. Balmoral Swimming Pool
Design and construct permanent structure to replace existing "air hall" over pool area.
