
To authorize the purchase of permanent easement rights for the purpose of access to a storm water management pond


Section 6 of the Municipal Act 2001 authorizes the Council of every corporation to pass a by-law for acquiring or expropriating any land required for the purposes of the corporation. The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is necessary and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to acquire the easement rights herein described for access to maintain a storm water management pond.


NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**



The acquisition of permanent easement rights at nominal cost from Airport 407 Business Campus Inc. for access purposes over of those parts of Lot 14, Concession 7, Southern Division, in the City of Brampton, designated as Parts 7, 9 and 11 on Plan 43R-31337 on terms and conditions acceptable to the Commissioner of Works and Transportation and in a form of agreement approved by the City Solicitor, together with all other documents that in the opinion of the City Solicitor are necessary to effect the purchase of the said easement rights, is hereby authorized.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 1st day of August, 2007.
