BY-LAW

Number 237-87

To amend By-law 193-83 (the regulation of traffic)
for the placement of an
ALL WAY STOP, SCHOOL BUS LOADING ZONE and PARKING REGULATIONS

The council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby
ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 193-83, as amended, is hereby further amended:

(1) by adding to the specified columns of Schedule VIII
thereto the following items:

THROUGH HIGHWAYS

<u>COLUMN 1</u> <u>HIGHWAY</u>	<u>COLUMN 2</u> <u>BETWEEN</u>
Major William Sharpe Drive	The north limit of the road and the north limit of Burgby Avenue/Gowland Gate
Major William Sharpe Drive	The south limit of Burgby Avenue/Gowland Gate and the north limit of the Queen Street West

(2) by adding to the specified columns of Schedule IX
thereto the following items:

STOP SIGNS

<u>COLUMN 1</u> <u>INTERSECTION</u>	<u>COLUMN 2</u> <u>FACING TRAFFIC</u>
Major William Sharpe Drive & Burgby Avenue/Gowland Gate	Northbound on Major William Sharpe Drive
Major William Sharpe Drive & Burgby Avenue/Gowland Gate	Southbound on Major William Sharpe Drive
Major William Sharpe Drive & Burgby Avenue/Gowland Gate	Eastbound on Gowland Gate
Major William Sharpe Drive & Burgby Avenue/Gowland Gate	Westbound on Burgby Avenue

(3) by adding to the specified columns of Schedule I thereto the following items:

NO PARKING ON SPECIFIED HIGHWAYS

COLUMN 1 HIGHWAY	COLUMN 2 SIDE	COLUMN 3 BETWEEN	COLUMN 4 TIMES OR DAYS
Welbeck Drive	North & East	A point 45 metres west of Northwood Drive (southerly intersection and a point 99 metres west and north of Northwood Drive (southerly intersection)	Anytime
Hayden Court	South	Hilldale Cres and Huckleberry Square	Anytime

(4) by adding to the specified columns of Schedule XII thereto the following items:

SCHOOL BUS LOADING ZONES

COLUMN 1 HIGHWAY	COLUMN 2 SIDE	COLUMN 3 BETWEEN	COLUMN 4 SCHOOL OR INSTITUTION
Duncan Bull Drive	North	A point 40 metres east of Belfountain Court and a point 100 metres east of Belfountain Court	Parkway Public School

Sub-sections 1,2 & 4 of this by-law shall not come into force until approved by the council of The Regional Municipality of Peel.

READ a FIRST, SECONND, and THIRD TIME and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL, this 14th day of October ,1987.
