A By-law to require an election
to be held.

WHEREAS Mrs. Nancy Porteous, with the consent of the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton (herein called the "City") has resigned from her office as a member of the Council of the City and the Council of the City has, by resolution dated the 10th day of September, 1979, declared seat to be vacant;

AND WHEREAS section 45(1) of The Municipal Act provides that where a vacancy occurs in the office of a member of the Council of a local municipality, the Council may, by by-law, require an election to be held to fill the vacancy and where the Council passes such a by-law, the Clerk shall hold a new election to fill the vacancy in accordance with section 90 of The Municipal Elections Act, 1972.

The COUNCIL of The Corporation of the City of Brampton
ENACTS as follows:

1. That an election be held to fill the vacancy in the office of the member of the Council for Ward 7 created by the resignation of Mrs. Nancy Porteous.
