
To accept and assume a certain
part of Cassander Crescent


WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to accept and assume certain
lands as parts of public highways;

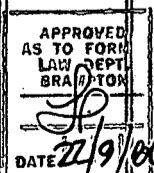
NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City
