# BY-LAW

Number 252-79

Being a By-law to prevent the application of part lot control of certain plans of subdivision in the City of Brampton. (Plan M#110)


WHEREAS subsection 29(4) of The Planning Act (R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 349, as amended) has imposed part lot control on all registered plans within the City;


AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 29(5) of The Planning Act, the Council of the Municipality may by by-law provide that such part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 4 of Section 29 of The Planning Act, does not apply to the land that is described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
2. This By-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by the Regional Municipality of Peel.

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
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
