BY-LAW

Number 260-87

To amend By-law 200-82
(former Town of Brampton
Comprehensive Zoning By-law)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 200-82, as amended, is hereby further amended:

(1) by deleting therefrom, section 6.14(a), and replacing therefor the following:

"6.14(a) an angled parking space shall be a rectangular area measuring not less than 2.70 metres in width, and 5.4 metres in length."

(2) by deleting therefrom, section 6.15(d), and replacing therefor the following:

"6.15(d) Aisles leading to parking spaces and providing unobstructed access from each parking space to a driveway shall be established on the following basis:

<u>Angle of Parking</u>	<u>Minimum Aisle Width</u>
(1) up to 50 degrees	4.0 metres
(2) 50 degrees up to 70 degrees	5.75 metres
(3) 70 degrees up to and including 90 degrees	6.6 metres."




