The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 56-83, as amended, is hereby further amended:

- (1) by changing, on Sheet 21 of Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from AGRICULTURAL (A) to INDUSTRIAL FOUR (M4) - SECTION 669 (M4-SECTION 669).

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this 10th day of September 2001.

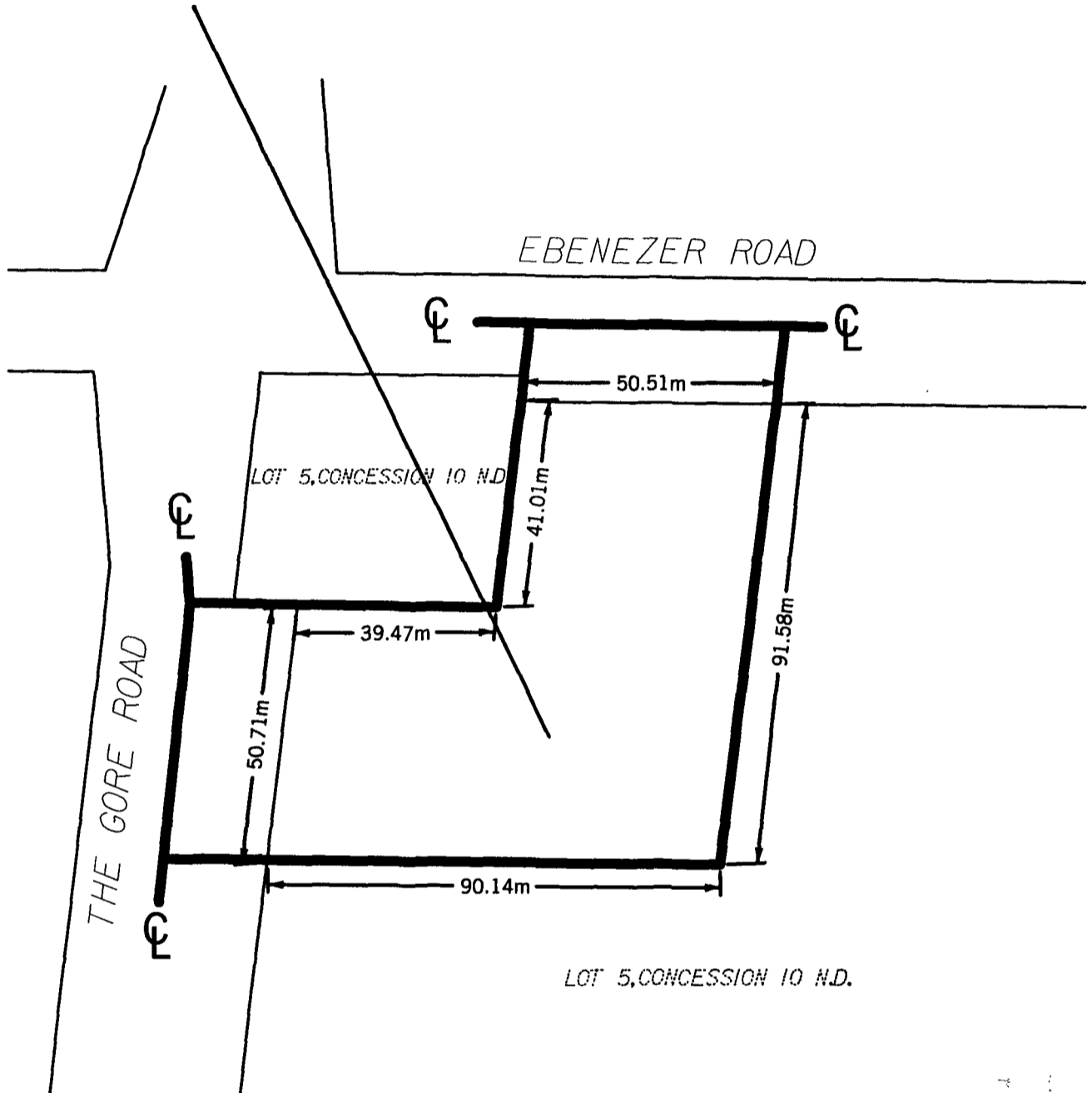

- m METRES



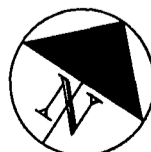

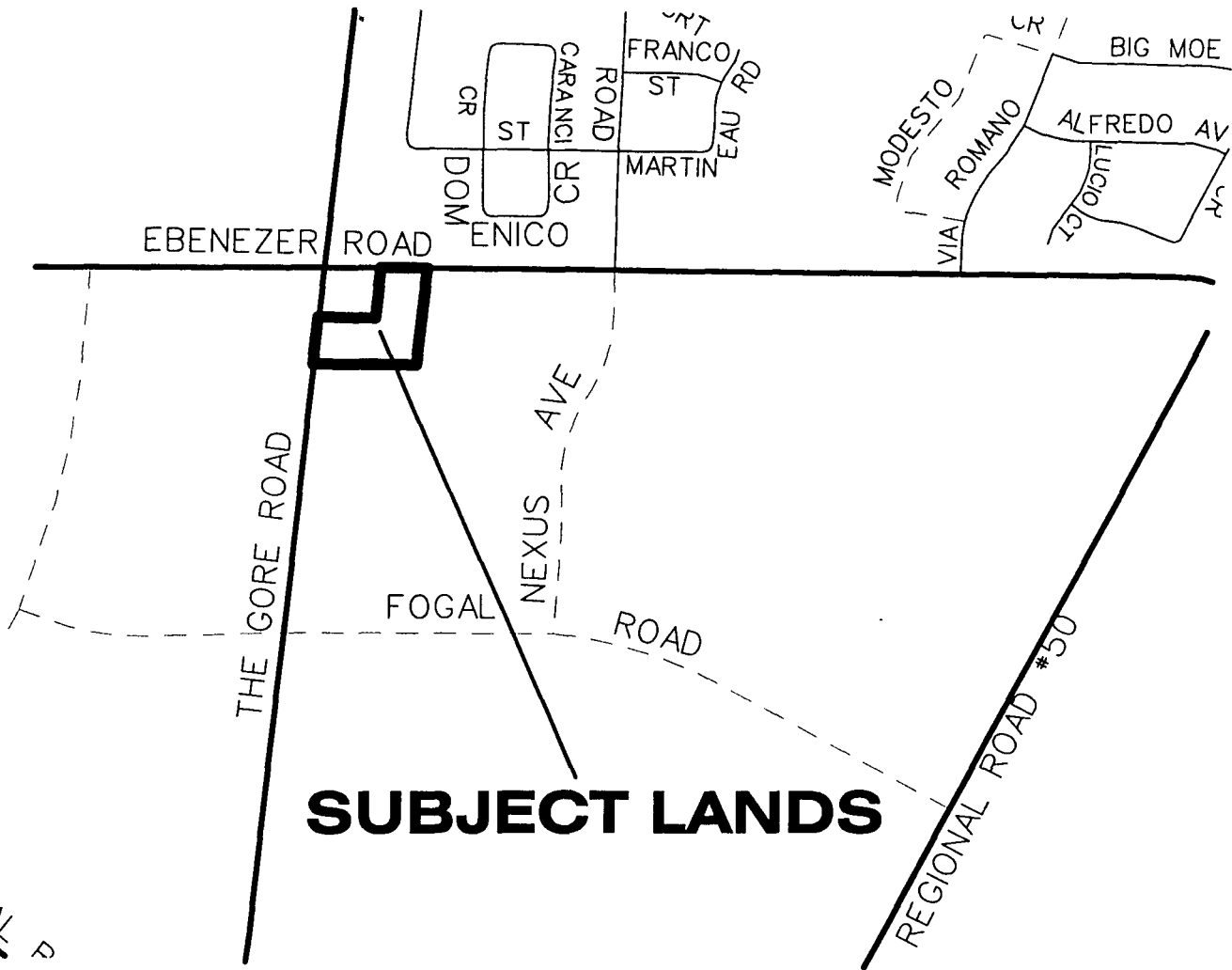

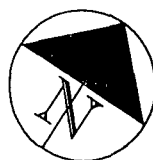

DECLARATION

I, LEONARD JOSEPH MIKULICH, of the City of Brampton, Region of Peel, DO SOLEMNLY DECLARE  
THAT:

1. I am the Clerk of The Corporation of the City of Brampton and as such have knowledge of the matters herein declared.
2. By-law 264-2001 was passed by the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton at its meeting on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2001, to adopt Amendment Number OP93-168 to the 1993 Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area.
3. The City of Brampton approved the aforementioned Amendment on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2001.
4. By-law 265-2001 was passed by the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton at its meeting held on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2001, to amend Comprehensive Zoning By-law 56-83, as amended.
5. Written notice of By-law 264-2001 as required by section 17(23) and By-law 265-2001 as required by section 34(18) of the *Planning Act* was given on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2001, in the manner and in the form and to the persons and agencies prescribed by the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990 as amended.
6. No notice of appeal was filed under sections 17(24) and 34(19) of the *Planning Act* on or before the final date for filing objections.
7. In all other respects this Official Plan Amendment has been processed in accordance with all of the *Planning Act* requirements including regulations for notice.
8. OP93-168 is deemed to have come into effect on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2001, in accordance with Section 17(27) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.
