To appoint an Acting Clerk




AND WHEREAS the City Clerk will be absent during the period October 17th to October 30th, 1979 (both inclusive) on vacation;

To appoint an Acting Clerk

WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Brampton is a body corporate and as such has the power to make laws for the better government of the City of Brampton and as it is deemed expedient that the Corporation should have an Acting Clerk to perform the duties of the Clerk of the Corporation and as the Corporation has the honor to receive the following resolution:

Resolved that the Corporation do hereby appoint Mr. [Name] to the office of Acting Clerk of the Corporation for a term of one year commencing on the 10th day of October 1979 and until his successor is appointed and that the Corporation do hereby authorize the Mayor to execute all such orders and documents as may be required for the purpose of giving effect to this resolution.
