AMENDMENT NUMBER OP93 - 9
TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN OF THE
CITY OF BRAMPTON PLANNING AREA

1.0 Purpose:

The purpose of this amendment is to add to the list of amendments pertaining to Secondary Plan Area 1: Snelgrove, to include Amendment Number 9 to the document known as the 1984 Official Plan.

2.0 Location:

The lands subject to this amendment comprise a total area of approximately 39 hectares (96 acres) and are described as part of Lot 18, Concession 1, West of Hurontario Street, in the City of Brampton. The lands are situated at the northwest corner of the intersection of Highway Number 10 and Mayfield Road.

3.0 Amendment and Policies Relative Thereto:

The document known as the Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area is hereby amended:

- (1) by adding to the list of amendments pertaining to Secondary Plan Area 1: Snelgrove, as set out in Part II: Secondary Plans, Amendment Number 9 to the document known as the 1984 Official Plan.
