



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 272-2007

To declare surplus and authorize the transfer of easement over Part of Block 141, Plan 43M-1029, designated as Parts 1 to 6, both inclusive on Plan 43R- 29980

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that a transfer of easement over Part of Block 141, Plan 43M-1029, designated as Parts 1 to 6, both inclusive, on Plan 43R-29980 (the "Lands") be conveyed to The Regional Municipality of Peel (the "Region");

AND WHEREAS the Lands were conveyed as a valleyland open space block to the City for nominal consideration through the development of Plan 43M-1029 and the Region now requires an easement over the Lands for watermain service;

AND WHEREAS the procedures required by By-Law 273-2005 have been followed;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The transfer of easement for nominal consideration over the Lands in favour of the Region is hereby authorized; and
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments approved by the City Solicitor as may be necessary to effect the transfer of easement over the Lands.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 12th day of September, 2007.
