# BY-LAW

Number 282-80

To stop up and close and sell  
part of Titan Road

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WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton has assumed Titan Road as a public highway;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient by The Corporation of the City of Brampton that a certain part of Titan Road be closed and stopped up, and sold to the owners of the abutting lands;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Daily Times, a newspaper published in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the said Corporation has given notice to the Regional Municipality of Peel, pursuant to section 51 of The Regional Municipality of Peel Act, 1973, and the Regional Municipality of Peel has indicated that it does not object to such stopping up;


AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The part of Titan Road more particularly described in Schedule A attached to this by-law be and the same is hereby stopped up and closed.
2. The sale, to the owners of the abutting lands, of the land stopped up and closed by this by-law for the sum of \$15,000.00, with the purchasers to pay all legal, advertising, surveying, reconstruction, and other associated costs, is hereby authorized.

3. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments necessary to complete the sale of the land stopped up and closed by this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council, this 27th day of October, 1980.

Schedule A to By-law 282-80

The land situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Township of Chinguacousy, in the County of Peel), being the part of Titan Road designated as Part 1 on a reference plan in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) as number 43R-8396, Titan Road itself being composed of the parts of Block C, according to a plan of subdivision registered in the said Land Registry Office as number 640, designated as Parts 1 and 2 on the said reference plan 43R-8396.
