# BY-LAW

Number 299-79

A By-law to Amend By-law  
Number 33-79 being a by-law  
for the Regulation of Traffic

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient and advisable to amend By-law Number 33-79, being a by-law for the regulation of traffic;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby enacts as follows:-

1. By-law Number 33-79, as amended, is hereby further amended:
  - i) By the deletion of the numbering from all subsections of Section (1) of Part I
  - ii) By the addition to Section (1) of Part I of the following definition of "Public Transit Vehicle" between "Pedestrian Crossover" and "Road Building Machine":
    - (a) ' "Public Transit Vehicle" means a motor vehicle owned by or operated for a Municipal or Provincial authority which is designed for carrying ten or more passengers and used solely for the transportation of persons upon payment of a prescribed fee . '
  - iii) By the addition to Section (2) of Part 7 of the following subsection:
    - " iii) Where compliance therewith would be impractical due to the placement of bus stops for public transit vehicles, the provisions of Section (13) of Part 5 shall not apply to public transit vehicles."
2. By-law Number 33-79 is hereby further amended by the addition to Schedule XIII of the following items under the appropriate columns thereof


Designated Turning Lanes

3. The provisions of Section 2 of this by-law shall not become effective until approved by the Council of the Regional Municipality of Peel.
