BY-LAW

Number 300 -2006

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M-1695

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

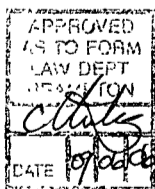
AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating lots for semi-detached dwelling units on Lots 3, 7, 14, 15, 18, 50, 51, and 52 and for creating maintenance easements on Lots 53 to 66, both inclusive, 68 to 74, both inclusive, 76, 77, 78, 80, 81, 82, 83 84, 85, 89, 92, 94, 95, 96, 97, 99,100, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 110, 111, 112, 113, 115, 121, 122, 123, 124, 125, 126, 127, 128, 130, 132, 133, 139, 140, and 144, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act does not apply to the following lands: City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of: Lots 3, 7, 14, 15, 18, 50, 51, 52, 53 to 66, both inclusive, 68 to 74, both inclusive, 76, 77, 78, 80, 81, 82, 83 84, 85, 89, 92, 94, 95, 96, 97, 99,100, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 110, 111, 112, 113, 115, 121, 122, 123, 124, 125, 126, 127, 128, 130, 132, 133, 139, 140, and 144 on Registered Plan 43M-1695.
2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the Planning Act, this by-law shall expire on September 11, 2009.
