registered plans within the City;


AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 29 (5) of The Planning Act,




NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 15th day of December, 1980.




