BRAMPTON'S DCM PRODUCES US POSTAL STAMPS

Did you know that any US stamp that is sold in a vending machine in the US is produced here in Brampton? DATA Communications Management Corp. PET VALU'S LARGEST CANADIAN DISTRIBUTION CENTRE OPENS IN BRAMPTON

At 670,000 sq ft, Pet Valu's new state-of-the-art facility in Brampton is not only their largest specialty distribution centre in Canada, but it also features the largest retail AutoStore robotics automation in the entire country. Pet Valu is a great Canadian success story and this investment brings up to 500 skilled jobs to our city, bringing new opportunities to our community. Opened in September 2023, their new facility in Brampton is at the heart of their transformative investment in next generation logistics technology.





MEDTECH TASK FORCE

Set to open in July 2024, Axium Packaging's new \$80M manufacturing facility near Dixie/Hwy407 is bringing 250 jobs to our community. With 20 plants across the United States. Canada and Mexico, Axium is a leader in design engineering and tool building for packaging needs such as plastic containers, tubes, caps and high-end decorating services. In line with Brampton's climate goals, Axium prioritizes eco-friendly initiatives in every aspect of their business. 


MDA BILLION DOLLAR CONTRACT
