#### Phase 1: Main Street & Theatre Lane/Chapel Street

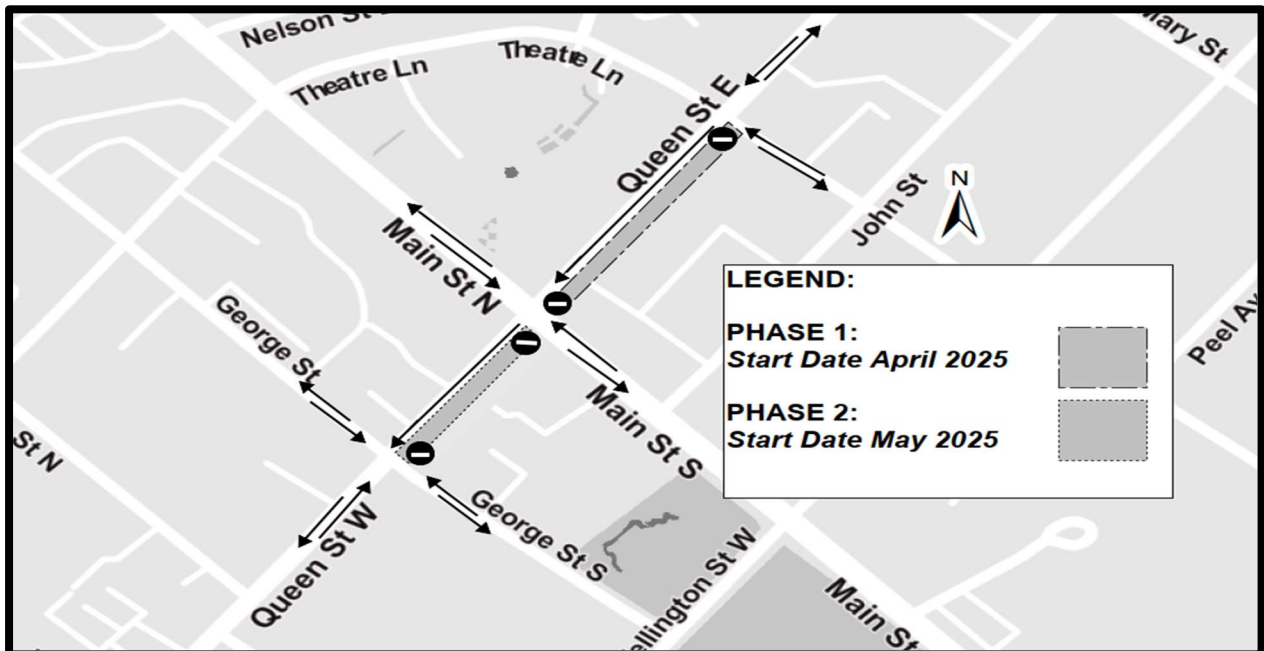
#### Phase 2: Main Street & George Street

**Downtown Brampton Streetscape Project**  
**Start Date: April, 2025 End Date: August, 2025**  
*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Brampton is continuing work on the Downtown Brampton Streetscape work. The work on the north side of Queen Street East between Main Street and Theatre Lane/Chapel Street will shortly be completed. The construction zone will shift to the corresponding south side of Queen Street between Main Street and Theatre Lane/Chapel Street, originally schedule April 2025.

The construction activity will be in two phases each phase lasting for roughly three months. Phase 1 construction zone will be on the south side of Queen Street East between Theatre Lane and Main Street effective early April 2025. Phase 2 construction zone begins later, on the south side of Queen Street West between Main Street and George Street effective May 2025. Phase 1 and 2 construction zones are to be active concurrently until completion of Phase 1. Queen Street will be reduced to one lane of westbound traffic within the construction zones when active. Motorists are reminded to abide by traffic/construction signs posted in local areas to ensure the safe travel of all local road users, pedestrians, and cyclists.

## WORK DETAILS

The contractor will:

- Reduce Queen Street East to one lane of westbound traffic between Main Street and Theatre Lane/Chapel Street for Phase 1
- Reduce Queen Street to one lane of westbound traffic between Main Street and George Street for Phase 2.
- Maintain pedestrian access to businesses on south side of Queen Street.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The community will experience dust, noise and traffic delays.
- The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. Your patience is appreciated

	<p><b>Pedestrians:</b> Sidewalks will be kept open for pedestrian use. When work is taking place on the sidewalk, signage will be placed to provide information about which side of the road to use.</p>
