
Phase 3C: Mill Street South and Elizabeth Street South

Downtown Brampton Streetscape Project
Start Date: March 25, 2026 End Date: June 2026
**Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Brampton is advancing work on the Downtown Brampton Streetscape Project. With forecasted mild ambient conditions in March and April, construction work will resume in the construction zone from Elizabeth Street South to Mill Street South as of March 25.

Phase 3C construction zone begins on the south side of Queen Street West between Mill Street South and Elizabeth Street South. Queen Street will be reduced to one lane of westbound traffic from Elizabeth Street South to Mill Street South. Motorists are reminded to abide by traffic/construction signs posted in local areas to ensure the safe travel of all local road users, pedestrians and cyclists.

WORK DETAILS

The contractor will:

- Reduce Queen Street West to one lane of westbound traffic between west of Mill Street South and Elizabeth Street South for Phase 3C.
- Maintain pedestrian access to businesses on the south side of Queen Street.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The community will experience dust, noise and traffic delays.
- Local access to driveways will be maintained for businesses along the closed sections of Queen Street West.
- **The City is committed to minimizing impacts wherever possible.** Your patience is appreciated.

	<p>Pedestrians: Sidewalks will be kept open for pedestrian use. When work is taking place on the sidewalk, signage will be placed to provide information about which side of the road to use.</p>
