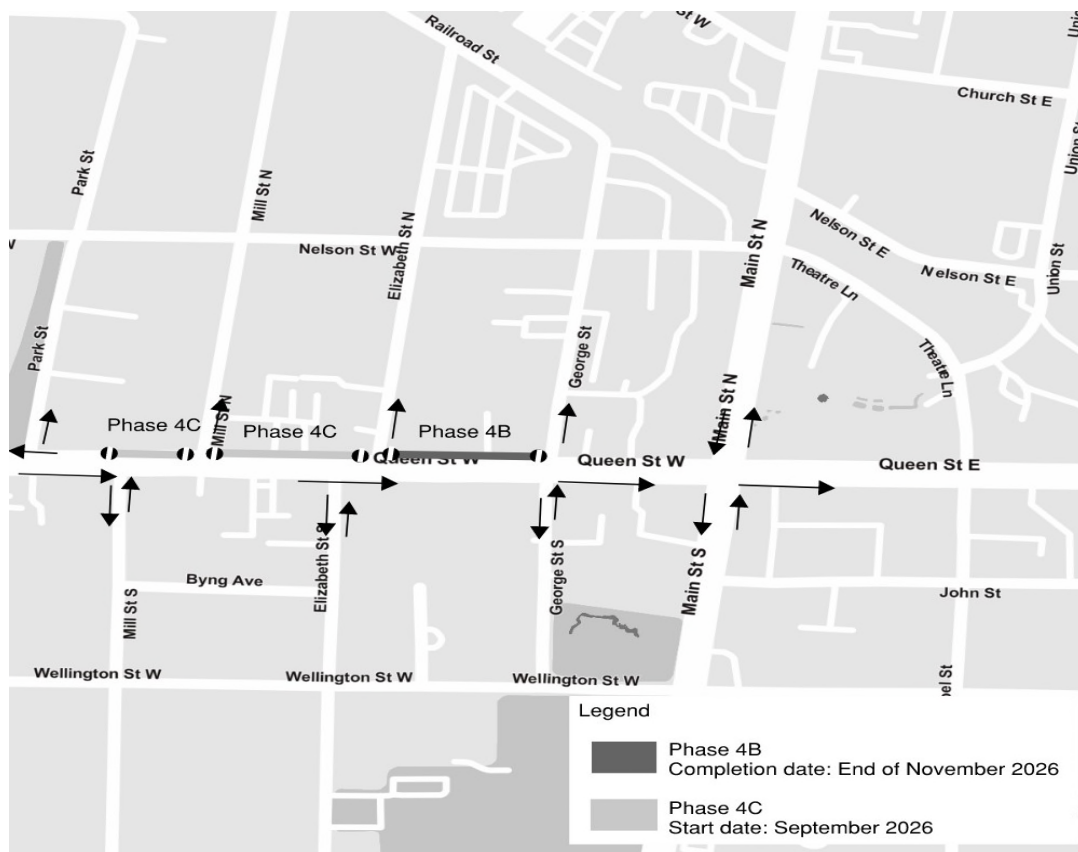

The City of Brampton is progressing with the Downtown Brampton Streetscape Project. Construction on Phase 4C will begin shortly, while work on Phase 4B (Elizabeth Street North to George Street North) continues.

Phase 4C will take place on the north side of Queen Street West, between Elizabeth Street North and Park Street, and will run concurrently with Phase 4B, which is scheduled for completion by the end of November 2026. During this time, Queen Street will be reduced to a single eastbound lane from George Street North to Park Street. Motorists are reminded to follow all posted traffic and construction signage to help ensure the safety of all road users, including pedestrians and cyclists.

Map of Work Area

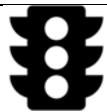


Construction Impacts

- Queen Street West will be reduced to one eastbound lane between Park Street and George Street North.
- Pedestrian access to businesses on the north side of Queen Street West will be maintained.

What to Expect During Construction

- The community may experience dust, noise and traffic delays during construction.
- Local access to driveways will be maintained for businesses along Queen Street West.
- The City is committed to minimizing impacts wherever possible. Your patience is appreciated.
- Please be advised that on-street parking in this area will be permanently removed.

	Queen Street West between west of George Street North and Park Street will be reduced to one eastbound lane. Access to emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
	Sidewalks will remain open for pedestrian use throughout construction. When sidewalk work is underway, signage will direct pedestrians to a safe crossing.
	Loading zones on Queen Street West will be permanently removed. Alternate loading zone locations are available on George Street North and Elizabeth Street North.
	Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard) to avoid damage. If you have any concerns about the removal of private items, please contact the Field Ambassador listed below.
	Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. , Monday to Friday.
