Declaration of Qualification

Do Solemnly Declare That:

1. I am qualified pursuant to the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, as amended, and the *Municipal Act, 2001*, to be elected to and to hold the above noted office.
2. Without limiting the generality of paragraph 1, I am a Canadian citizen, at least eighteen years of age, a resident of the City of Brampton or the owner or tenant of land in the City of Brampton or the spouse of such owner or tenant.
3. I am not ineligible or disqualified under the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, the *Municipal Act, 2001*, or any other *Act* or otherwise prohibited by law to be nominated for, elected to or hold the above-mentioned office.
4. Without limiting the generality of paragraph 3, I am not:
 - i. Prohibited from voting in the municipal election according to the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, or otherwise by law
 - ii. A person who was convicted of a corrupt practice under the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, or of an offence under the *Criminal Code (Canada)*, in connection with an act or omission that relates to an election to which the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, applies
 - iii. A person who is ineligible to be nominated for, or elected to any office until the next two regular elections have taken place after the election to which the offence relates
 - iv. A member of the Legislative Assembly of Ontario, Senate, or House of Commons of Canada, unless I provide proof of my resignation in a form satisfactory to the Clerk of the City of Brampton prior to 2 pm on Nomination Day, August 21, 2026
 - v. A judge of any court
 - vi. An employee of the City of Brampton, unless I have taken an unpaid leave of absence

- vii. An employee of the Region of Peel, unless I have taken an unpaid leave of absence (for candidates for Regional Councillor only)
- viii. A person not employed, but holds an administrative position with the City of Brampton
- ix. A Clerk, Treasurer, Integrity Commissioner, Auditor General, Ombudsman, Lobbyist Registrar as referenced in sections 258 (1) ii and 223.11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*
- x. An investigator as referenced in subsection 239.2(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*
- xi. A public servant as referenced in the *Public Service of Ontario Act, 2006*, except in accordance with Part V of that Act
- xii. A federal employee as referenced in the *Public Service Employment Act*, except in accordance with all relevant provisions of Part 7 of that Act

5. Without limiting the generality of paragraph 4, I am not ineligible to be elected to any office to which the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, applies by reason of any violations of the election campaign financial requirements or violations for not filing the financial statement pursuant to the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*.

AND I make this solemn Declaration conscientiously believing it to be true, and knowing that it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath and by virtue of the *Canada Evidence Act*.
