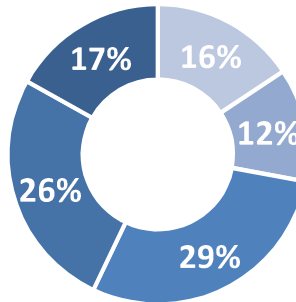

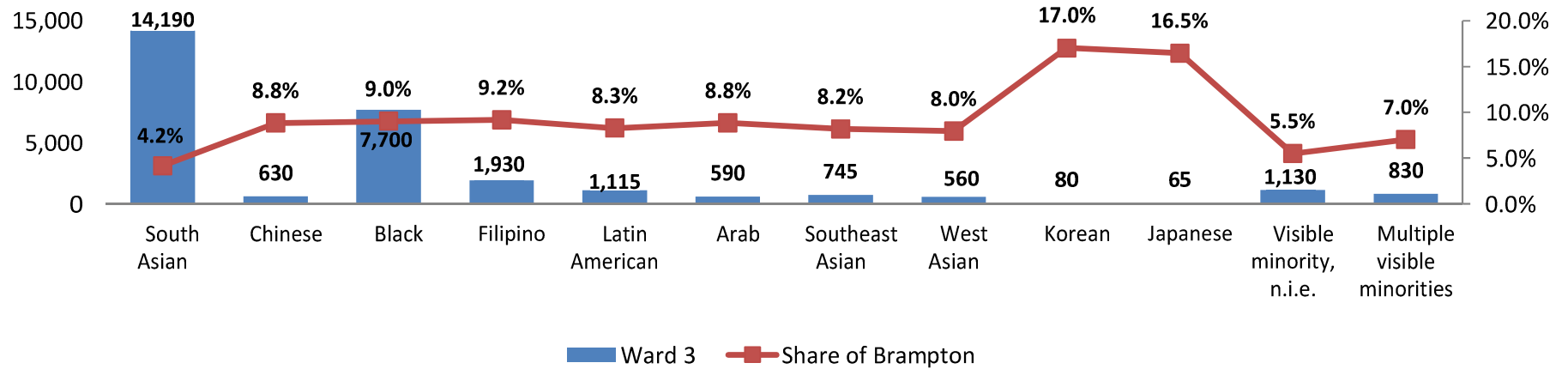

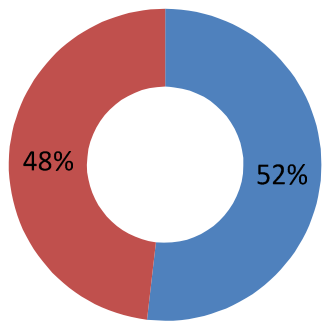

**2021 Total population by visible minority (Ward 3)**



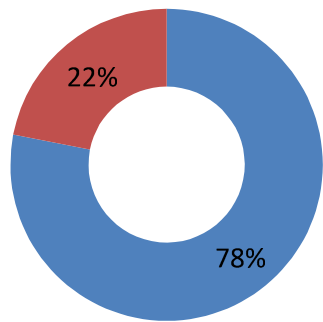

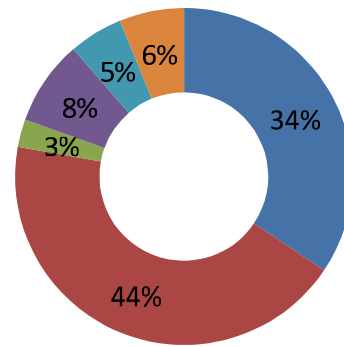

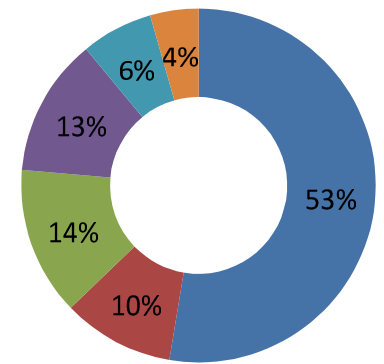

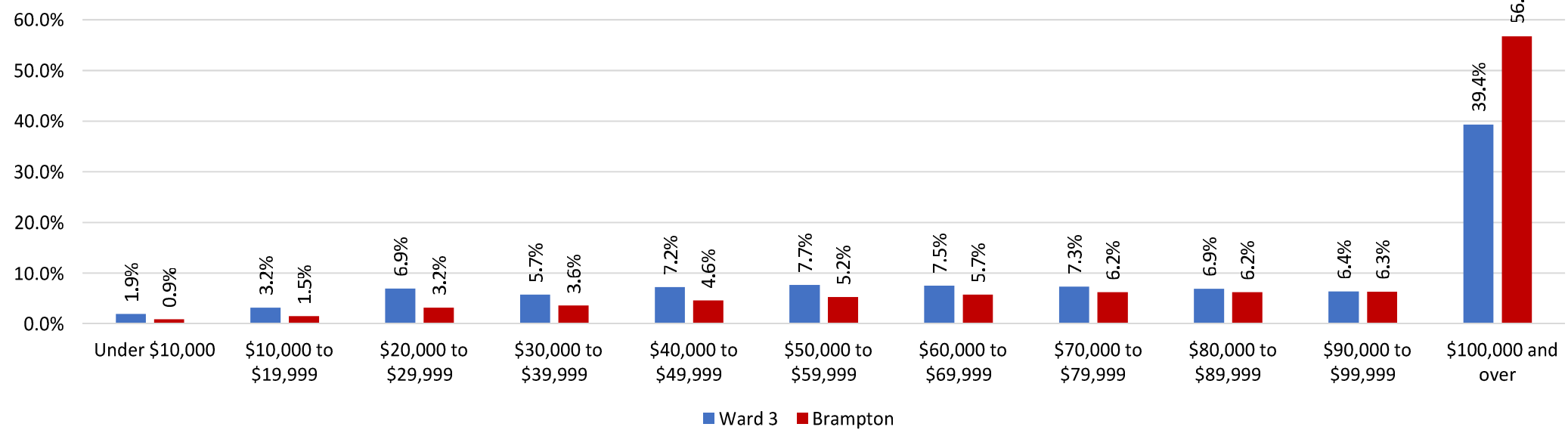

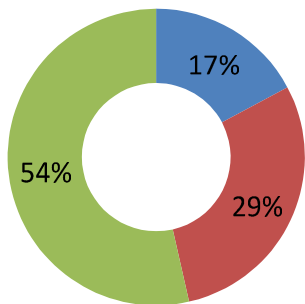

**Household total income groups in 2020 for private households**

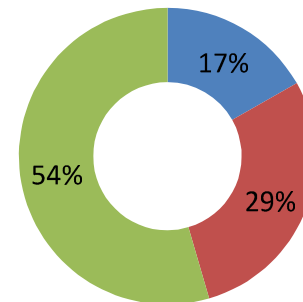
